

## **THE BARRINGTON CENTRE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

**Adopted on 11 November 2019**

The Barrington Centre Management Committee will consist of 7 Members of the Town Council

The Committee has responsibility and delegated power to oversee the management and improvement of the Centre.

1. To keep under review the proposed re-development in consultation with Dorset Council.
2. To manage the operating funds within the Centre's budget, and to vire funds available within this budget.
3. To make recommendations for the pricing structure of the facilities.
4. To review the facilities available within the Centre for the different groups of residents and to consult with interest groups about matters within the committee's remit.
5. To oversee the management of the Café/Bar/Theatre and Community Rooms.
6. To monitor and make recommendations to the Personnel Committee for any staffing requirements.
7. To determine the amount of budget requested for its activities and to make recommendation to the Finance and General Purposes Committee for the necessary precept.

### **Delegated to the Mayor, Chairman or Vice Chairman of the Committee (acting together)**

At the request of the Town Clerk and in circumstances deemed to be exceptional and urgent (e.g. health and safety matters) to exercise any powers within the purview of their Committee provided they are satisfied that the decision cannot wait for the next meeting, is not against known Council policy, is financially viable or defensible and is reported to the next ordinary meeting of the Committee. In the event that the Chairman and/or Vice Chairman are absent and cannot be contacted, then this power shall pass to the Town Mayor and/or Deputy Town Mayor of the Council or another member acting with one of those members.
